Each year the RSPB organises the Big Garden Birdwatch, an annual event which uses volunteers to count the birds they see in their garden to come up with a list of the 10 most common garden birds in the UK.

Common garden birds - Saga

Blackbird - Blackbirds are one of our more common garden birds with the male being black with a distinctive yellow eye ring and beak, whilst the female is a plainer brown. Blackbirds may nest earlier than most birds but it said that they will actually nest at any time of year. Often seen finding worms in the Summer and will take fruit in the Winter.
