Tumors Of The Central Nervous

Tumors of central nervous system may be classified into tumors of neuroepithelial tissue, tumors of cranial and paraspinal nerves, neuronal and mixed neuronal glial tumors, tumors of meninges, lymphomas and hematopoietic neoplasms, germ cell tumors, tumors of sellar region, familial tumors and metastatic tumors.

Adult Central Nervous System Tumors Treatment (PDQ ...

A central nervous system (CNS) tumor begins when healthy cells in the brain or the spinal cord change and grow out of control, forming a mass. A tumor can be cancerous or benign. A cancerous tumor is malignant, meaning it can grow and spread to other parts of the body. A benign tumor means the tumor can grow but will not spread.

WHO classification of tumours of the central nervous system

Malignant primary tumors of the central nervous system are mainly represented among adults by glial tumors, both low-grade and high-grade. Rare tumors such as medulloblastomas , ependymomas , intracranial germ-cell tumors , and pineal region tumors are most commonly observed among young adults, but can appear at any age.
